## Wavy Stitch Hat and Scarf Set - Adult - Woman or Man Size

Skill level: Easy
Size: Adult woman; finished size of hat - approximately 24 " around (for loose fit), and $7.5^{\prime \prime}$ from crown to bottom edge; finished size of scarf -5.5 " wide by approximately 6 feet long.

Gauge: Take the time to make a sample swatch in the Wavy Stitch pattern to measure your gauge. If you have more rows or stitches per inch, use a larger crochet hook. If you have fewer stitches or rows per inch, use a smaller crochet hook.

In the Wavy Stitch pattern, 4 DC = 1 inch; 2 rows = 1 inch

## Materials:

Worsted weight (Group 4) yarn - 4 ounces of each color

- Color A (main color/dark color) - 4 ounces
- Color B (multi-color/variegated) - 4 ounces
- Color C (light color) - 4 ounces

Size H/8 (5.0 MM) and I/9 (5.5 MM) crochet hooks
Blunt-ended yarn needle

## Special Stitches:

Increase: work 3 DC in the same stitch
Decrease: worked over 3 stitches, YO, draw yarn through next stitch, YO and draw yarn through 2 loops on hook (leave the rest unworked), YO, draw yarn through next stitch, YO and draw yarn through 2 loops on hook (leave the rest unworked), YO, draw yarn through next stitch, YO and draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, YO and draw through remaining 4 loops on hook

## Instructions for Hat:

Striping pattern: Color A - 4 rows; Color B-2 rows; Color C - all remaining rows

## Starting at the bottom/brim of the hat:

With Color A and size I/9 crochet hook, leave a long tail and chain 83 . Change to size $\mathrm{H} / 8$ hook for the first row/round of the hat.

Round 1: With color $A$ and size $\mathrm{H} / 8$ crochet hook, DC in $4^{\text {th }}$ chain from hook, DC in next 3 chains, Decrease, *DC in next 3 chains, Increase, DC in next 3 chains, Decrease*. Repeat from * to * to the last 4 chains, DC in next 3 chains, 2 DC in last chain. Join to top of first stitch being careful not to twist this round.

Round 2: Chain 2, DC in same stitch as joining, DC in next 3 stitches, Decrease, *DC in next 3 stitches, Increase, DC in next 3 stitches, Decrease*. Repeat from * to * to the last 4 stitches, DC in next 3 stitches, 2 DC in last stitch. Join in top of first stitch (not in the chain 2 at the beginning of the round).

Rounds 3 \& 4: Repeat Round 2 in Color A for two more rounds. Fasten off. Change to Color B by working in same stitch as the joining on Round 4.

Round 5 \& 6: With Color B. Repeat Round 2. Fasten off. Change to Color C by working in same stitch as the joining on Round 6 .

Round 7: With Color C, SC in same stitch as joining, SC in next stitch, HDC in next stitch, DC in next 3 stitches, HDC in next stitch, *SC in next 5 stitches, HDC in next stitch, DC in next 3 stitches, HDC in next stitch*. Repeat from * to * around to last 3 stitches, SC in last 3 stitches. Join. Do not fasten off.

Round 8: Chain 2, DC in same stitch as joining, DC in next 3 stitches, DC 2 together, *DC in next 4 stitches, DC 2 together*. Repeat * to * to last 2 stitches, DC 2 together. Join. Do not fasten off.

Round 9: Chain 2, DC in same stitch as joining, DC in next 2 stitches, DC 2 together, *DC in next 3 stitches, DC 2 together*. Repeat * to * around to last 2 stitches, DC in next 2 stitches. Join. Do not fasten off.

Round 10: Chain 2, DC in same stitch as joining, DC in next stitch, DC 2 together, *DC in next 2 stitches, DC 2 together*. Repeat * to * around to last 2 stitches, DC 2 together. Join. Do not fasten off.

Round 11: Chain 2, DC in same stitch as joining, DC 2 together, *DC in next stitch, DC 2 together*. Repeat from * to * around to last stitch, DC in last stitch. Join. Do not fasten off.

Round 12: Chain 2, DC in same stitch as joining, *DC 2 together, DC 2 together*. Repeat from * to * all around. Join. Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew closed the opening at the crown/top of the hat.

To close the opening at the top of the hat: Thread the yarn needle with the long tail at the crown of the hat. Weave in and out of the stitches of Round 12 (like a drawstring). Pull up snugly to close the opening at the top of the hat. On the inside of the hat, sew the opening closed. Weave in the loose end and fasten off.

To join the opening at the brim/bottom of the hat: Thread the yarn needle with the long tail and sew the tow edges of the first round together. Weave in loose end. Fasten off.

## Instructions for Scarf:

Striping pattern: Color A - 4 rows; Color B-2 rows; Color C - 2 rows.
With Color A and Size I/9 crochet hook, chain 243. Change to size H/8 crochet hook.
Row 1: With Color $A$ and size $H / 8$ crochet hook, DC in $4^{\text {th }}$ chain from hook, DC in next 3 chains, Decrease, *DC in next 3 chains, Increase, DC in next 3 chains, Decrease*. Repeat from * to * to the last 4 chains, DC in next 3 chains, 2 DC in last chain.

Row 2: Chain 3, DC in first stitch, DC in next 3 stitches, Decrease, *DC in next 3 stitches, Increase, DC in next 3 stitches, Decrease*. Repeat from * to * to the last 4 stitches, DC in next 3 stitches, 2 DC in last stitch.

Rows 3 \& 4: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off Color A at the end of Row 4. Join Color B.
Rows 5 \& 6: With Color B, repeat Row 2. Fasten off Color B at the end of Row 6. Join Color C.
Rows 7 \& 8: With Color C, repeat Row 2. Fasten off Color C at the end of Row 8.
Weave in loose ends.
